Simcha Guidelines

A Bris or Kiddush can be made in either Bais Medrash or in the Simcha Hall, provided it does not disrupt regular Shul schedules. Any other *simcha* should be celebrated in the Hall.

The Shul's Simcha Hall is available for paying members only, for personal *simchos* only. The Shul is available for Brissim by paying members only. **A *simcha* hosted by a paying member on behalf of a relative may also make use of the Shul at an increased cost.** The Shul is not otherwise available for use for *simchos* for non-members.

So as not to disturb the regular function of the Shul, limited live music is permitted only at certain times (e.g. Sunday afternoon). Please speak to the Gabbai for more details.

The hall can be reserved up to 6 months in advance.

Fees for Members:

- \$100 – Shalom Zachor or Kiddush in Simcha Room
- \$150 – Weekday Bris (\$300 – Non-member)
- \$200 – Weekday use of the Simcha Hall (\$400 – Non-member)
- \$350 – Shabbos Kiddush/Bris Upstairs
- \$400 – Use of the Hall for Full Shabbos (may include kiddush as well) (\$850 – Non-member)

Responsibilities of the Baal Simcha:

- ✓ Ensure that the Hall is broom swept, chairs and tables stacked by midnight, that day.
- ✓ Return tables and chairs in Bais Medrash to proper locations.
- ✓ Remove all props, food and personal items from the Hall and kitchen by 12AM Sunday night.
(Anything left in the hall after that time will be deemed *hefker* and will be discarded.)
- ✓ Ensure that all garbage is placed in the bins neatly.
- ✓ Reimburse the shul for any damages to the hall or furniture.
